



Youth Educational Shoplifting Program (Y.E.S. Program)

The Y.E.S. Program is a comprehensive, “offense-specific” education program, which helps juveniles identify the feelings, thoughts and attitudes which lead them to shoplift and helps them make better choices for themselves and their future. This interactive program, developed by the National Association for Shoplifting Prevention (NASP), was designed as a means of early intervention to help prevent juveniles from repeating the offense and provide them with the tool needed to move on to a successful future.

Participant Registration:

- Enter your Court Number : **002**
- Complete the Registration Form – be sure to indicate the name of the court/agency and person who referred you to the program
- The tuition Fee for the Y.E.S. Program is: **\$55.00**
- Payment is due at the time of registration, and may be made online with a credit, debit or prepaid card. **If you need more time to register, need to make alternate payment arrangements or have any questions, contact NASP immediately.**

Your official Completion Letter will be emailed to you within one business day of completing the course and a copy will be forwarded to the court/agency that referred you (if applicable). You may also print a temporary Exit Letter, which you should keep until you receive your official Completion Letter.
